BINS AND DINS


Objective: To develop phonological awareness on the production of aspiration

Material: A board like the one shown below

Procedure:

Divide the classroom in groups. Give each student a board and tokens.

Choose one of the animals from the Polar Bear's Pin story which are above the arrow and write this name on a card.



The teacher reads phrases or words with /b/ or /p/. Every time students listen to the phrase with aspiration they move a token to the 'pin' on the Polar Bear square. Likewise, if they listen to a phrase with no aspiration they move the token to the square with the 'bin'.

The winner is the student who reaches the animal the teacher has written on the card.

Student one from each of the groups take the teacher's role and go on playing the game in groups

Phrases or words to be read aloud:

- 5. A bird's beak
