Game Name:

A JOURNEY INTO THE MOUTH

Objective: To explore the roof of the mouth/ organs of speech.

Material: The story pictures and a mirror

Procedure:

Explain children that they are going to go into a journey into their mouths and discover new places.

Suggest starting by the tip of the feather. It is a metaphorical word used in the story to refer to the tip of the tongue. Some other metaphorical



words in the story include a `comfy sofa' that is behind the upper teeth. It is a metaphorical word used in the story to refer to the alveolar ridge. Teachers can also refer to the `little hill' behind their upper teeth.

Teacher: Let's begin!! Are you ready!!!

Take a mirror. Now, look inside your mouth. What can you see?

Now, find the tip of the feather inside your mouth! What is it? Do you know any other name for it?

Let's use this feather to discover other places.

Use the tip of the feather to feel the upper teeth. How does it feel? soft? hard?

Now, let's use the tip of the feather to find the comfy sofa that is behind the upper teeth. Can you feel it? It is like a small hill. Is it comfy?.
